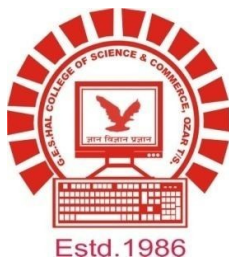

Best practice 1: ISO 9001:2015 Certification

College is ISO Certified Unit. WE Gokhale Education Society has more than 25 College and 50 schools and educational institutes, all are ISO Certified. Earlier it was 9001:2008 upgraded to 9001:2015 now. Our two staff members namely Prof. U.S. Surve, Vice-Principal and Mr. P.D. Padekar, IQAC coordinator are certified Internal Auditors for ISO Certification.

Best practice 2: KITE FESTIVAL - UNDER WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

Goal: The main motive of this intercollegiate competition is to enhance the capacity of the girl students and ladies staff, to upgrade the empowerment skill among the women and to promote gender equity

The College organizes intercollegiate Kite Festival exclusively for the girl students and women staff of the colleges and schools from the Nashik City. This is a consistent activity run by the College for the past 4 years. In last 4 years we have received more than 500 participations which shows the popularity of this event not only among the Ozar area but around Nashik city. Last year due to pandemic situation this event was organized through online mode in which we received more than 30 participants.

The event focuses on achieving the following objectives:

- Development and enhancement of skills of girl students and women staff
- Personality development
- Exposure and an opportunity to interact with the world

Best practice 3: Tree plantation and Census drive

The college initiated a tree plantation and census drive at the adopted village of NSS Unit of the College, at Shirwade (Wani), Tal. Niphad, Dist. Nashik. We have done the census of almost all the trees in and around the Shirwade village and same is submitted to the Forest Department, NSS Director SPPU, Pune and to the Collector of Nashik District. Every Tree is labeled with a bar code having an information as Name, Scientific Name, approximate age of Tree, Use of Tree, etc. Any one can scan the code and get the information on mobile on single click. We have recorded upto 13000 trees around village. Some trees/species are useful on diabetic and cancer related diseases.

All these efforts have contributed towards minimizing the usage of electricity, focussing on paperless work, initiating and maintaining a green campus, fulfilling the social commitment and creating environmental awareness among all stakeholders. E-waste is generated from worn out computers, other hardware, mobiles, electric appliances etc. It consists of hazardous materials such as lead, zinc, lithium batteries, tin etc. Improper disposal of these products is dangerous for living beings. The e-waste and plastic waste is collected and given to the agency for proper disposal.
